

Ready-Pets-Go!

Get Ready Now to Care for Your Pets During Emergencies

Ready-Pets-Go! is a do-it-yourself emergency preparedness plan for households with animals in the family. Lollypop Farm's checklist of 11 simple ways to prepare helps to ensure that your family is ready to care for your pets when the unexpected happens.

- All of my pets have collars and identification.
- O My pets' vaccinations are up-to-date.
- O My pets are micro-chipped.
- O I have a "mutual aid" agreement with a neighbor to check on each other's pets if one of us cannot get home during an emergency.
- O I have a planned destination—a relative or friend—in case I have to evacuate my home with my pets.
- I have one week's supply of food and water, supplies such as litter, and two weeks' medication, on hand for each pet.
- I have a carrier for each small pet and leashes for each dog.
- All of my pets can fit in my vehicle, or I have an alternate plan.
- O I have a photo of each pet in case he or she becomes lost, and a photo of myself with each pet to prove ownership.
- I have copies of health records for each pet to take along if evacuating.
- My veterinarian has my written authorization for a person I have chosen who may seek medical care for my pets if I cannot.



Once you've completed each of the 11 items on the list, you are **READY** to get your **PETS** and **Gol** in case of an emergency. Further details on disaster preparedness for pets can be found at Lollypop Farm's website.
