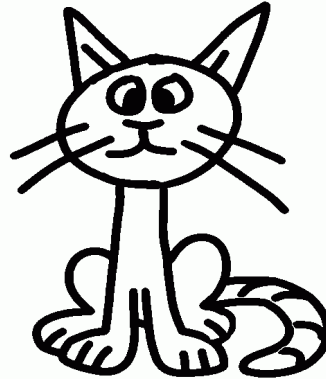

Please remember that this is a wellness schedule and if your pet ever becomes ill additional tests and diagnostics may be necessary.



### 75-85% of cats over the age of 3 have dental disease!

Cats are not supposed to have bad breath. They have bad breath because they do not brush their teeth. Brushing your cat's teeth is beneficial for both your pet and your pocketbook. Advanced dental disease can be costly and painful to your cat. We encourage home oral brushing, water additives and routine dental cleaning.

### "Senior at Eight"

Cats do not age the way people do – they age much faster. Most cats are considered seniors at eight years of age. Be sure to visit your veterinarian regularly to catch the signs of aging early and help your cat live gracefully into their older years.
